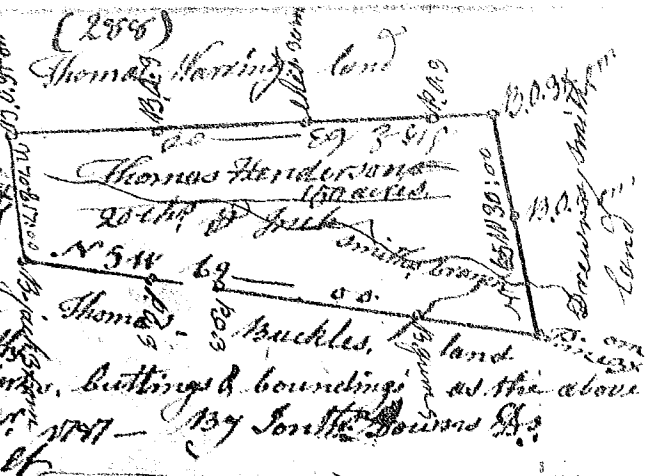
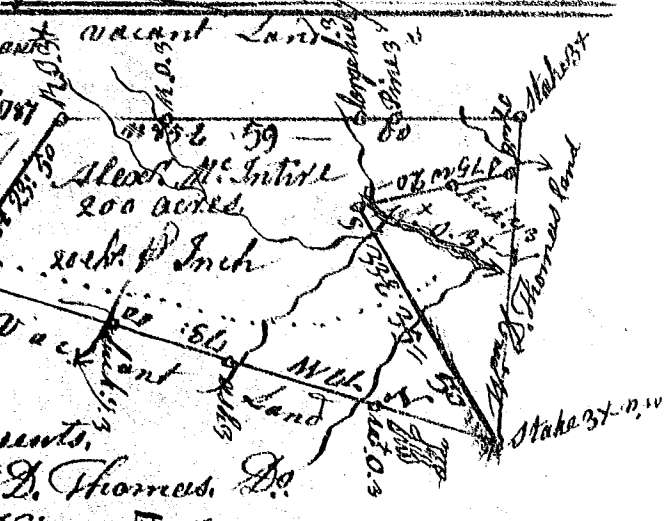

S.W. E. on or near Wm. Grant's land, S.W. S.E. N.E. S.E. by vacant land, and S.E. S.W. by land surveyed for Robt. Miller, and hath such form & marks as the above Plat represents.
