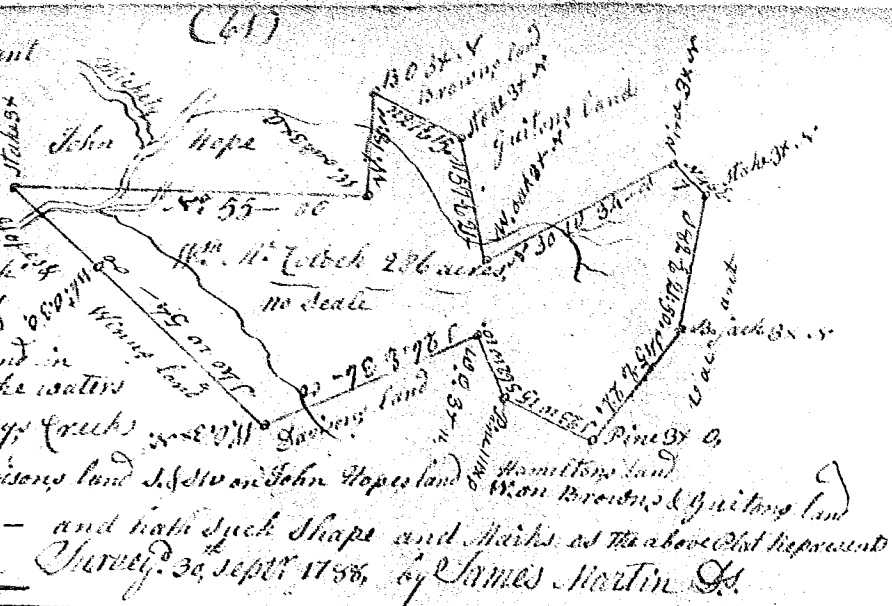
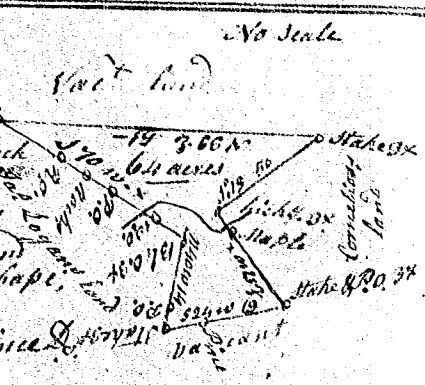

Carolina, Dated 20th Dec. 1788, I have admeasured and laid out unto Robert Miller a tract of 66 acres of land, in Greenville County, Mountains branch of Saluda River, Bounded by lines running S. and S. on lands of Benjamin Connerly, by lines running S 70° W & N 40° W on land of Sept. Logan and all other sides by vacant land, and hath such shape, form & marks as the above Plat represents.



South Carolina, Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Comr. of the Dist. of S. Carolina, Dated 5th July 1788, I have admeasured and laid out unto William Jameson a tract of Two hundred & forty acres in said District on the 2^d fork of Little Creek of S. Pacolet river, bounding on all sides on vacant land, and hath such shape & marks as the above Plat represents.



South Carolina, Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Comr. of the Dist. of S. Carolina, Dated the 6th July 1788, I have admeasured and laid out unto William Jameson a tract of 90 acres of land in said District on Little Creek of S. Pacolet river, bounding by lines running E & S on land laid out John Mc Cleck, & S. by lines running S & W on lands laid out to William Jameson & on all other sides on vacant land, and hath such shape and marks as the above Plat represents.
