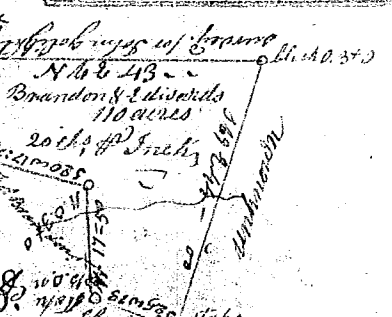


South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant (288)
