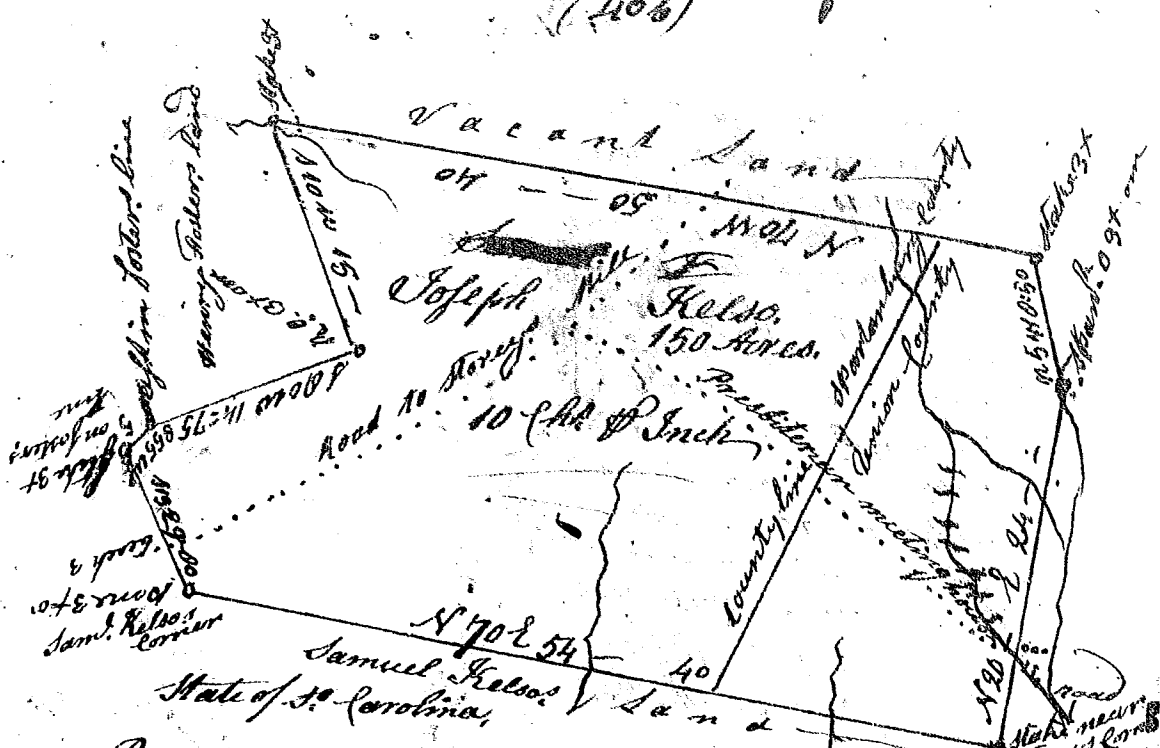

Anthony Person S.W. by James Neidbatt, all other sides by land surveyed for Thomas Penny, and hath such form & Markes as the above plat represents.
