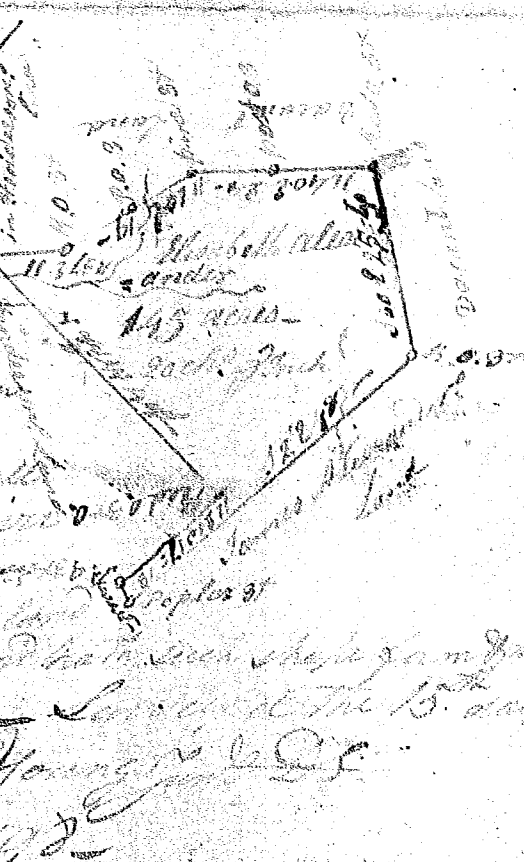


South Carolina 1435

I have surveyed and laid out unto John Holland a tract of one hundred and sixty three acres of land lying in Pinckney District, Spartanburg County, on both sides of two small branches of South Fork of the river bounded to the north by Henderson's land to the west by James Hill's land to the east by vacant land, and to the south by the above plat representing the 15th day of December 1797.
