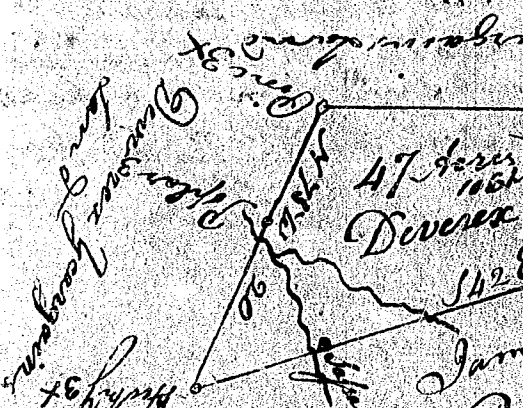
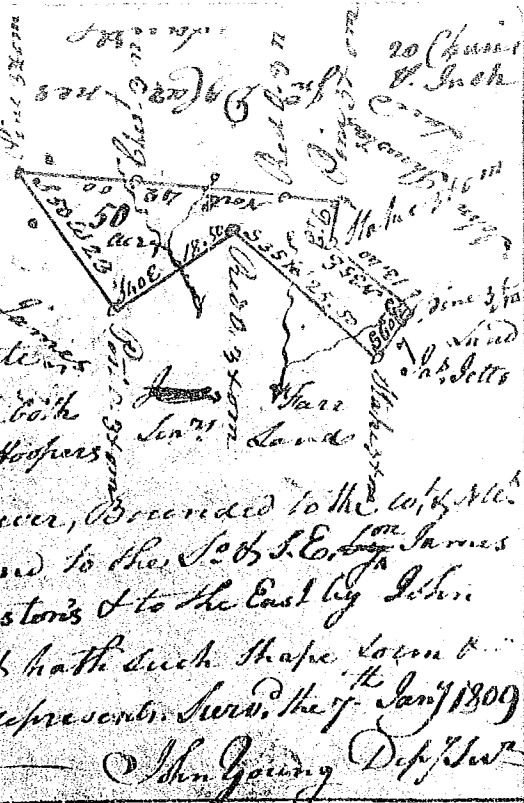


South Carolina (50)

C. James Jett's Land & John Thrustons & to the East by John Daniel Carnes's land, & hath such shape & marks as the above plat represents. Survey, this 7th Jan^y 1809
