 middle fork of Saluda River bounded  
 South westerly by lines running S 47 E N 43 E  
 and S 70 E by land belonging to Henry Wolf  
 Johnson & Lee Waldrop Eastwardly by Joseph  
 Cobbs Land, N E wardly by lines running N 43 W by  
 Land belonging to John Young N W wardly by lines  
 running N 66 W due to N 53 W by John Young  
 Land & John Gouvenor Land and hath such shapes  
 and marks as the above plat represents  
 Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of Novr 1815
