Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esqr Comms<sup>r</sup> of Locations dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1820, I have admeasured and laid out unto Alexander McHenry a tract of one hundred and twenty acres of land situated in Greenville District on both sides of a fork of Fall Creek of Checharon of Saluda River bounded Westwardly by Ward's land Eastwardly by vacant land, Southwardly by said McHenry's land and Westwardly by vacant land and hath such shape and marks as the above plat represents,
