C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 65, Page 128, and the same conveyed to Mary E. Hightower by J. J. Hightower by deed dated January 13, 1921, and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 88, Page 182. The said Mary E. Hightower has died and by the terms of her will on file in Apartment 195, File 22, Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, devised to the undersigned J. C. Hightower the above described property for life and at his death said property to be equally divided among the undersigned Ernest Hightower, Annie Noe, and Leby Hightower.
