Martin, in the full and just sum of Three thousand (\$3000.00) Dollars, to be paid Payable at Greenville, South Carolina, on the 1st day of January, 1921, and thereafter annually or in part attorney at law and interest thereon, from the date of execution of this note, at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid.

Interest on this note until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$33. per cent. per cent. per annum to be

Martin, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (allowance which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

I, C. B. Martin, and T. C. Gower, do hereby execute and deliver unto the said W. D. Parrish, and C. B. Martin, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the principal sum of Three Dollars, to the said,

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, make, sell and release unto the said W. D. Parrish, and C. B. Martin, the following described property,

All that certain parcel or lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as lot No. 2 of the Parrish, Gower, and Martin property as shown by plat of same recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 8, at page 197 and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of McDaniel Ave. at joint corner of lots 1 and 2, thence along McDaniel Ave. to iron pin is 66.5 feet north of the intersection of McDaniel Ave. and Watt Ave. and run thence along line of McDaniel Ave. N. 4-32-18° 66.5 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 2 and 3; thence a long joint line of said lot N. 85-38° 187 feet to iron pin in line of lot 2; thence along the joint line of lots 2 and 3 S. 4-22-18° 66.5 feet to iron pin rear corner of lots 1 and 2; thence along the joint line of last mentioned S. 85-38° 187 feet to the point of beginning.

This being the same property conveyed to me by W. D. Parrish, T. C. Gower, and C. B. Martin by deed dated - yet to be recorded. This understand and agreed that the lien of the aforesaid mortgage is junior and inferior to the lien of a mortgage in the principal sum of \$6500.00 executed on even date herewith by Anna Belle R.
