The above two tracts were conveyed to J. H. Mc Gowan
and W. H. Welch, and by right thereof to W. H. Mc Gowan
by deed dated March 18, 1918, recorded in book 28,
page 137.

Also that other tract of land in Townships, Concord
and St. Paul adjoining, containing 36 3/4 acres, adjoining
W.L. Rockland & H. Leech, which was part of the
tract conveyed to J. G. Brown and Decatur by A. H. French
