NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said R. C. Henderson

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said People's National Bank, of Greenville, S.C. all my right, title and interest in and to all that tract or lot of land in Batler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On Peters Creek and branch waters of Hickory Creek, Waters of Enoree River, and known as a part of the David Huguenin place, and having the following lines and bearings, to wit: Beginning on a Maple & 40m on Peters Creek and running thence N. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 19.50 to a stone 340m; thence S. 54 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 18.50 to a stone 340m; thence N. 4 E. 20.83 to a stone 340m; thence N. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 19.35 to a stone 340m; thence S. 44 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. 11.00 to a stone 340m; thence S. 26 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 11.85 to a stone 340m; thence S. 39 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 9.00 to a stone 340m; thence S. 44 W. 3.70 to a stone in mouth of branch and in Peters Creek 340m; thence down the meanderings of said Creek 20.00 to the beginning corner and contains  $\frac{9}{16}$  acres more or less, adjoining lands of David Holtzman, Jr. Smith and others.

This is the same tract of land conveyed to R. C. Henderson and John J. Henderson by S. Elizabeth Montgomery, by deed dated November 1, 1904 and recorded in R. J. M. C office for Greenville County in Book 2000, at page 2313. Said John J. Henderson, who was the husband of the said R. C. Henderson died intestate February 25, 1930 leaving as his sole heirs at law and distributees the Maryagor R. C. Henderson, his widow, and nine living children and five children of a deceased child, and this marriage is intended to give the one half interest of the Maryagor as grantee in the deeds to the property and he is one third of one half taken as the widow of John J. Henderson, making two thirds interest.
