TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, the said Mary C. Blakely

THE UNION CENTRAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY of Cincinnati, Ohio, a corporation organized under the laws of Ohio, and having its principal place of business in the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio, in the sum of Fifty Seven hundred thirty three Dollars (\$5733.68) evidenced by certain promissory notes of even date herewith, of which amount Three thousand & 00/100 Dollars \$3000.00 is money loaned more fully described as follows:

The first note being for the sum of one hundred thirty & 00/100 DOLLARS, the next note for the sum of one hundred eighty three & 00/100 DOLLARS each, the last being payable on the 1st day of April, 1934, and one of the remaining notes being payable on same day in each of the succeeding twenty years, (or prior to maturity in accordance with stipulation therein), with interest after maturity at the rate therein specified.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that the said Mary C. Blakely hereinafter called the mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and the sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof and of said notes, as well as any renewals or extensions of said notes or of said indebtedness, or of any part thereof, however evidenced, with interest on such renewals, extensions or indebtedness, at such rate of lawful interest as may be agreed upon and any notes given for interest covering any renewals or extensions of said notes or indebtedness, with interest thereon from maturity of the same (which renewals or extensions of the notes or debt for any part thereof, hereby secured, or any change in the terms of or rate of interest payable on same, shall not impair in any manner the validity of, or priority of this mortgage) to the said THE UNION CENTRAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY of Cincinnati, Ohio, hereinafter called the mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS (\$3.00) to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said mortgagee, all that tract or parcel of land and premises, hereinafter particularly described, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid:

beginning at an iron pin in the northwestern corner of tract and running S 20 1/2 E 32.90 chains to iron pin; thence S 41 W 21.75 chains to iron pin; thence S 27 W 13 1/2 chains to stone; thence S 60 E 3.96 chains to stone; thence S 69 E 17.85 chains to stone; thence N 25 E 20.42 chains to stake; thence N 7 1/2 W 15 chains to stone; thence S 69 E 6.42 chains to stone; thence N 83 E 23.32 chains to stone; thence N 20 1/2 E 26 chains to stone in public road; thence with said public road first N 76 E 3.89 chains to bend; thence N 43 E 24.12 chains to stone; thence N 71 1/2 E 4.48 chains to stone; thence N 71 W 15.06 chains to stone; beginning point containing 83.92 acres as shown on plat made by W. J. Middle, August 1921, this being the same property conveyed to me by E. M. Blakely by deed dated February 19, 1914 recorded in the R. M. C. pages 23-24 of book 44 - at Greenville, S. C.
