WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of \$100.00 (\$400.00)

Mechanics Building and Loan Association, O. G. C. 18. Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereon the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to wit:

Know all by us, that we do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part, the following described land:

Begins at a stake on the south side of Bishop Street 200 feet east of Lexington Street, corner of lot No. 55, and runs thence with line of Bishop Street S. 55° 40' E. 50 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 59; thence with line of said lot S. 48° 30' W. 50 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 55; thence with line of said lot N. 55° 40' W. 50 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 59; thence with line of said lot N. 55° 40' W. 50 feet to the beginning.

Being the same lot conveyed to me as trustee for R. L. Loftis by the Mechanics Building & Loan Association by deed of even date herewith, and not yet recorded.
