All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the building and improvements thereon situate on the north side of West Stone Avenue in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 24 on plat no. 5 of lands of Mountain City Land & Improvement Company and having, according to said plat, which is recorded in the R. M. L. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 21 at page 605, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of West Stone Avenue 103 feet west from the northwest corner of the intersection of West Stone Avenue and Milton Street, and running thence along the north side of West Stone Avenue N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 54 $\frac{1}{3}$  feet to a stake at the corner of lot now or formerly belonging to Lena H.
