with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of five (5%) per cent., said principal and interest to be paid at its principal office in Greenville, S. C., as follows:

Beginning on the 1st day of August, 1937 and on the 1st day of each and every month thereafter the sum of \$50.00 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue monthly until the entire principal and interest have been paid in full; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$50.00 each to be applied first to interest at the rate of five (5%) per cent. per annum to be computed and paid monthly on the principal sum of \$5,300.00, or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal thereto.

To be computed and paid at the rate of seven (7%) per cent. per annum, on the amount unpaid, and any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being at the Southeast corner of Sevier Street and Augusta Road in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to plan recorded by L. M. Turnan, Jr. Engineer, August, 1925, the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin, the Southeast corner of Sevier Street and Augusta Road, and running thence with Augusta Road, S. 45 E. 99.5 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 21-23 W. 216.5 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 57-20 W. 140.3 feet to an iron pin on Sevier Street, thence with said street, N. 32-40 E. 228.5 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to the mortgagor herein by Southeastern Life Insurance Company, by deed of even date herewith and to be recorded simultaneously with this mortgage.
