C.

The sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars to be paid on the principal on the 13th day of September, 1934, and the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars on the 13th day of November, March, June and September of each year thereafter until the said principal shall be paid in full;

paid in full in 14th life

with interest thereon from

at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually on the 13th day of September, in each year until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest on the same at six percent; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate lying and being on the north side of Georgia Road west of the Town of Simpsonville in Fairview Township, Greenville County, S. C., known and designated as Lot No. 4 on plat of property of Claude B. Richardson, made by St. J. Riddle, Surveyor, February 17, 1937, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Georgia Road at corner of property of R. D. Jones and running thence with the line of R. D. Jones property, S. 15-16 E. 86° 5 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4; thence with the line of Lot No. 3, S. 7-20 E. 293.6 feet to a point in the center of Georgia Road; thence along the center of said road N. 48-36 E. 140' feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
