All that certain piece of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the southwest side of Augusta Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being more particularly designated as Lot No. 11, Block in plot of C. P. Mills property, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 6, page 176, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest side of Augusta Street, which iron pin is 72 feet from a north-south direction from the intersection of Augusta Street and Stone Road, and running thence ~~south~~ the line of Lot 12, S. 45-²⁷ 20/180 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44-²² 27. 72 feet to an iron pin, thence south ~~the line~~ of Lot No. 10, N. 45-²⁷ 6. 180 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Augusta Street, thence south ~~the line~~ of Augusta Street S. 48-²² 6. 72 feet to the beginning.
