*granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said SOUTHEASTERN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY*

All that certain piece of land with the  
buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and  
being on the north side of East Park Avenue (formerly  
Burke Street) in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville,  
State of South Carolina, being known and designated  
as Lot 28 on plat of H. L. Colenland property, recorded in  
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book  
13 and having, according to said plat, the following metes  
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of East  
Park Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots 28 and 29,  
and running thence with the line of Lot 29 N. 26-59 E.  
172.5 feet to a stake on the south side of a 15 foot alley;  
thence with the south side of said alley, S. 63-01 E. 70  
feet to a stake at the joint rear corner of Lots 27 and  
28; thence with the line of Lot 27, S. 26-59 E. 172.5 feet to  
a stake on the north side of East Park Avenue; thence with  
the north side of East Park Avenue N. 63-01 E. 70 feet to the  
beginning corner.
