quarterly, at the rate of six per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly, annually on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, in each year until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including attorney's fees, to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being on the north side of East North Street, in the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having, according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Revels, Engineers, March, 1927, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone on the north side of East North Street, which stone is 275 feet east of the northeast intersection of North and Brown Streets, and running thence along the north side of said East North Street S. 69-10 E. 73 feet to a stone in the line of Beattie property, thence along the line of said Beattie property, N. 30-50 E. 167 feet to an iron pin; thence still along said Beattie property N. 34-20 E. 64.8 feet to an iron pin in line of property of Thomas, thence along said Thomas line, N. 54-10 E. 89 feet to an iron pin in the line of property of Hodges, thence along the line of said Hodges N. 21-10 E. 253 feet to the point of beginning.
