and improvements thereon, situated, lying and being on the
western side of North Main Street in the block between
Coffey and Washington Streets in the city of Greenville, County
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having, according
to survey made by R. C. Dalton, Engineer, September, 1923,
the following metes and bounds, to wit:-

Beginning at a point in the center of the northern face of a 13 inch brick wall on the East side of North Main Street, which point is located 38.2 feet south of the southeast corner of Main and Coffee Streets and running thence with the center of said 13 inch brick wall and so South 70-23 East 144.2 feet to an iron pin in the center of an alley; thence with the center of said alley South 20 West 22.25 feet; thence North 70-23 West 144.2 feet to a point in the Eastern line of North Main Street, corner of other property of J. C. Gower et al. thence with the Eastern line of North Main Street North 20 East 22.25 feet to the point of beginning, together with all my right, title and interest in and to the alley and the use thereof referred to in the above description, which is more particularly shown by the survey hereinabove referred to.
