Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to wit:

In the City of Greenville, on the North side of Craft and Robinson Streets, known as Lot no. 2 on plat of property of T. B. Smith, recorded in plat book 6, page 215, the lots described on said plat being a revision of Lots 16 and 18, Section 13, Stone Land Company, bearing the following streets and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Robinson Street, 60 feet North of intersection of Robinson and Craft Streets, running thence N. 1.41 E. 60 feet to pin; corner Lot 3 on said plat; thence N. 85.39 W. 140 feet to pin; thence S. 1.41 W. 50 feet to pin, corner of Lot no. 1; thence with line of said Lot S. 85.39 E. 140 feet to beginning, being the same conveyed to me by Grace L. Launder by deed dated June 8, 1929, recorded in Book 107, page 94.
