N. 19-45 E. 212 feet to a small gum; thence S. 89 E. 60 feet to a
stone; thence N. 21-15 E. 500 feet to a stake; thence S. 82-30
E. 128 feet to a stone; thence S. 6 E. 255.5 to iron pin; thence
