All that piece, parcel or tract of land on which a mill, cotton gin, etc. is situated, beginning on a stone 34, Mrs. Harriet Stewart's corner and running S. 33' 1/2 E. 4.50 chains to a stone, thence S. 62' 1/2 E. 2.95 cho. to a stone in bank of creek at Ford on public road; thence N. 25 1/2 E. 4.47 to stone, thence N. 62 W. 10.34 cho. to stone; thence N. 72 W. 4.90 cho. to a dead post oak; thence N. 28 W. 4.44 cho.; thence N. 11 E. 3.50 cho. to dead post oak; thence N. 65 W. 11.40 cho. to a stone; thence S. 29 W. 3.31 cho. to a stone; thence S. 37 1/2 E. 18 cho. to a stone 34 in road; thence about Northeast 9.55 cho. with Middle gully to the beginning corner, containing 19 2/3 acres more or less, said tract of land being known as the Belue and Prevett Mill tract, lying on both sides of Garrison Mill Creek,
