WHEREAS, I, the said J. J. B. Wilson, in and by my certain power of attorney, even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Woodville Investment Company in the full and just sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars, 76/100, well and truly indebted to

with interest thereon, from the date computed and paid annually until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

one per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. J. B. Wilson, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Woodville Investment Company according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to

J. J. B. Wilson, in hand well and truly paid by the said Woodville Investment Company, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Woodville Investment Company

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and City of Greenville, on the Western side of Bay Avenue, and being described by Metre and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the Northern line of Bay Avenue at a point two hundred and seven (207) feet from the intersection of said Northern line of Bay Avenue with the Northern line of East Washington Street, said place of beginning being the corner of the lot of land now or formerly owned by G. D. Baker, and running thence along the dividing line between property of Woodville Investment Company and that of G. D. Baker, South 70 deg. 20 min. one hundred and one (101) feet to a stake; thence South 64 deg. 50 min. one sixty-one (61) feet, more or less, to the stake on the East line of a certain ten-foot alley; thence along the Eastern line of said alley South 17 deg. 10 min. East fifty-three (53) feet, more or less, to a stake on the Northern line of a certain nine-foot alley; thence along the Northern line of said alley North 60 deg. 50 min. East one hundred and sixty (160) feet to the Northern line of Bay Avenue; thence along said Northern line of Bay Avenue North 14 deg. 35 min. West forty-seven and seven tenths (47.7) feet to the place of beginning.

The lot of land herein conveyed is shown as Lot No. 4 on a certain map or plat as made December 20, 1921 by W. G. Lewis, Surveyor.
