## Mortgage of Real Estate

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Mrs. Nora Sherrill of Charlotte, North Carolina

in the State aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Mrs. Nora Sherrill, am justly indebted  
in and by  
to Sloan S. Sherrill of Baltimore, Maryland, in the sum  
of Six Hundred and no/oo (\$600.00) Dollars, evidenced  
by a note of even date herewith in said amount due  
in one year from date with interest from date at the  
rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually.

And the said mortgagor agrees to insure the house and buildings on said lot in a  
sum not less than six hundred and no/oo dollars in a fire and any other damage  
satisfactory to the mortgagor, and keep the same insured from loss or damage  
by fire and assign the policy of insurance to the said mortgagee, and that in  
the event that the mortgagor shall at any time fail to do so under the said  
mortgagee may cause the same to be insured in my name and expense  
me for the premium and expense of such insurance under this mortgage,  
with interest.

And if at any time any part of said debt, or interest thereof, be past due  
and unpaid, I hereby assign the rents and profits of the above described  
premises to said mortgagee or his executors, administrators or assigns  
and agree, that any judge of the Circuit Court of said State may at chambers  
or otherwise appoint a receiver with authority to take possession of said  
premises and collect said rents and profits, applying the net proceeds  
thereof (after paying costs of collection), upon said debt, interest, costs  
or expenses, without liability to account for anything more than the rents  
and profits actually collected.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I the said Mrs. Nora Sherrill,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Sloan S. Sherrill,

according to the condition of the said note.

and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said

Sloan S. Sherrill,

in hand well and truly paid by the said

Mrs. Nora Sherrill,

at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Sloan S. Sherrill, all rights and assignments forever:  
all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in the county and state  
aforesaid, on the south side of Buncombe Street in  
said one of the city of Greenville and having the  
following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of  
Buncombe Street at the corner of Mrs. Gilbreath's lot, and  
running thence along the line of Buncombe Street sixty  
(60) feet to a stake 3x feet the corner of a lot now formerly  
belonging to Mrs. Gilbreath; thence along the line of the said  
Latimer lot in a southerly direction one hundred thirty-  
eight (138) feet to a stake 3x; thence in a westerly direction  
sixty-seven (67) feet to a corner of Mrs. Gilbreath's lot; thence  
along Gilbreath line forty-six (46) feet to a land in the said  
line; thence along the balance of said line one hundred  
twenty-two (22) feet to the Beginning corner on the south  
side of Buncombe Street.

Being in all respects the same property conveyed  
to Mrs. Nora Sherrill by deed of Sloan S. Sherrill dated  
September 30, 1936 and duly filed for record in the  
Greenville County, S. C., Registry in Book 191, page 116  
to which deed and the deeds therein mentioned reference  
is hereby made.
