Mortgage of Real Estate

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

J. R. Tollison

in the State aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said J. R. Tollison, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to The Pelzer-Williamston Bank in the full and just amount of eleven hundred thirteen and 96/100 (\$1,113.96) Dollars, to be paid on demand after date, with interest thereon from date, at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be desired by the holder thereof, necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me the said

*J. R. Tollison*in hand well and truly paid by the said *The Pelzer-Williamston Bank*

at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *The Pelzer-Williamston Bank, its successors and assigns forever*: All that tract, parcel or piece of land lying and being situated on French waters of Reedy River in Fairview Township, State and County aforesaid, the same being the tract of land conveyed to S. W. Davenport by John F. Holcombe by deed bearing date of Dec. 31, 1914, and later conveyed by S. W. Davenport to Mrs. Emma Davenport by deed bearing date of Jan. 3d. 1915, and afterwards conveyed by Miss Emma Davenport to Mrs. Bessie Robertson by deed bearing date of Jan. 17, 1918. Said land being bounded by lands of S. M. Meares, Mrs. Alice Tollison and others, containing fifteenteen and one-fifth (19 1/5) acres, more or less, more fully described as follows: Beginning in center of road in rear of old gin house and running thence up said road 14 1/2 N. 6.00 to bend in road; thence N. 9 1/2 W. 4.00 to a point in road; thence N. 85 1/2 W. 19.30 to a stone; thence S. 34 W. 8.80 to a stone; thence S. 34 W. 8.80 to a stone; thence S. 85 1/2 E. 21.00 to the beginning corner.
