amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *Josephine Carson Mullinax*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars,
to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Paul J. Williamson*

all that tract or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.*

Land, situate on the Log Shoal Trail in Greenville County and described more par-
ticularly according to a plat made by G. H. Williams, Engr., Oct. 1924, as

feet to a stake; thence N. 1-53 E. 493.6 feet to a stake; thence N. 14-16
E. 267.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 35-16 E. 94.5 feet to a stake;
thence along line of said Pigeon Roost Creek W. 78-26 E. 263.4 feet
to a stake; thence N. 68-06 E. 331 feet to a stake; thence N. 70-56 E.
187.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 41-19 E. 146.6 feet to a stake; thence N. 69-31
E. 265.9 feet to a stake; thence N. 1-095 feet to the beginning point, and con-
taining 81.60 acres, more or less.
