Whereas, we the said *I. S. F. Lew, W. P. Faw and Ellie Faw*

note in writing, of even date with
these presents, are well and truly indebted to *The Fidelity Bank of Durham, N.C.*
in the full and just sum of *Nine Thousand, seven hundred and four Dollars*
to be paid. *Six months from date*
and day of December, 1884,
with interest thereon from *date* *Paid at the said bank of Broadwell cashier*
at the rate of *6* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Buy*
besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the
hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured
under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said *I. S. F. Lew, W. P. Faw and*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better

securing the payment thereof to the said *Fidelity Bank of Durham, N.C.*

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum

of Three Dollars, to us the said *I. S. F. Lew, W. P. Faw and Ellie Faw*
in hand well and truly paid by the said *Fidelity Bank of Durham, N.C.*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Fidelity Bank of Durham, North Carolina, the following
tract of land.

Tract 1. "Beginning at an iron pin in the northwestern
intersection of Main Street and Victoria Street, in the town
of Greenville, State of South Carolina aforesaid, and running thence
along west side of Main Street N. 78-50 E. 68.2 feet
to iron pin at southwestern intersection of Main and Church
streets, thence along the south side of Church Street N. 66-56
E. 170.0 feet to iron pin, thence still along said Church
Street N. 71-21 E. 43 feet to iron pin at corner of unnamed
street, thence along eastern side of said unnamed street
S. 64-17 E. 606.9 feet to iron pin on north side of Emma
Street; thence along north side of said Emma Street, S.
71-15 E. 152.3 feet to iron pin; thence still along said Emma
Street S. 47-03 E. 68.6 feet to the point of beginning. This
being the same property conveyed to our father, I. S. F. Lew,
now deceased, by William A. Hill my testator dated Dec. 12,
