is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. M. Babcock, his heirs and executors forever.

"All those several tracts of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, containing Sixty three and 42/100 (63.42) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of A. M. Stewart, Meekins, F. R. Cobb, David E. Chapman et al., more particularly described by a plat made by W. J. Piddel, Surveyor, September 26, 1934 to wit:

Beginning at iron pin at corner of lands of Ross Cobb and lands now or formerly of Estelle Meekins, running thence S. 33° E. 12,31 feet to a point in Public Road, thence S. 36° 30' W. 43 feet across said road to lands of Ross Cobb, thence S. 35° 29' feet to point on said road, thence S. 34° 30' E. 158 feet to iron pin, thence S. 56° 10' W. 1650 feet to stake, thence S. 44° 30' E. 577 feet to stake in Branch, thence N. 56° 30' E. 1557 feet to iron pin in road, thence N. 34° 30' W. 66 feet to iron pin in road, thence N. 52° 15' E. 984 feet to stone, thence S. 35° 10' E. 512 feet to stone, thence S. 34° 30' E. 160 feet to stone, thence N. 61° E. 185 feet to stone, thence N. 35° 24' 702 feet to stone, thence N. 52° 15' E. 299 feet to stake, thence S. 38° E. 746 feet to stone, thence N. 62° E. 320 feet to stake, thence N. 38° 30' W. 838 feet to stone along land of E. E. Chapman; thence N. 13° W. 375 feet to stone; thence N. 38° E. 500 feet along land of J. A.
