WHEREAS, I, *J. A. Barry*, the said, in and by my certain Promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to The South Carolina National Bank in the full and just sum of Seventeen Hundred Fifty (\$1750.00) and no Dollars, to be paid October 1st, 1935 at the South Carolina National Bank, Greenville, S.C.

with interest thereon, from February 1, 1935, at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all or either is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The South Carolina National Bank,

All, that lot of land of land lying, being and situated in the town of Mountain Inn, County and State of South Carolina, being the land conveyed to C. D. Purick and J. A. Barry jointly by J. W. Muller in the year 1920, and Conveyed to J. W. Muller by the Deacons of the Baptist Church, F. S. Jones, B. S. Lott and others, in the year 1898, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Bounded by land of Mrs. Nan Armstrong, 6 & W. C. R. R. Gard House, Depot lot, and alley.

Commencing at an iron pin on aley Gard House corner, running thence with the Gard House line 50 feet to an iron pin, thence 32 $\frac{1}{3}$ feet to an iron pin on Depot line, thence with Depot line 62 feet to an iron pin, thence with Depot line 27 feet to an iron pin near the Railroad side-track, thence up the said Railroad 55 feet to Mrs. Nan Armstrong's corner, thence along Mrs. Nan Armstrong's line 103 feet to an iron pin on aley, thence along said aley 50 feet to beginning corner.
