until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said V. M. Babb his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situate in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid, Containing Thirty and 6/10 (30.6) Acres, more or less, being fully represented upon a Plat made by J. A. Adams, October 20, 1913, of lands of W. H. Howard, deceased.

Beginning at a corner on road, Will Garrett's property, and runs thence S 87° 24.50 to iron pipe, thence S. 66 E. 3.75 to stone; thence S 47 E. 8.35 to stone; thence S. 48 1/2 W. 11.80 to stone; thence N. 61 3/4 W. 29.70 to stone in road; thence along said road N. 20 E. 5.17 to the beginning corner, and being the lands willed to me, Mary K. Templeton, by my father, W. H. Howard, and specifically referred to and mentioned in his Will in Apartment 98, File 25, Probate Judge's Office for Greenville County.
