Bessie to Steele,
in the full and just sum of *Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *one year from date*.

with interest thereon, from *21. 12. 1924* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10.00*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *21. 12. 1924*, *Steele*,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Steele*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *John A. Steele*, the said *21. 12. 1924*,

in hand well and truly paid by the said *John A. Steele*,

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said *John A. Steele*,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being in the first ward of the city of Greenville,
known as Lot no. 3 on plat made by A. E. Dalton, dated
May 1919, recorded in R. M. Co. Office for Greenville County
in Plat Book "E" at Page 132, and having the following
metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the
southeast side of Atwood St. on the north corner of Lot
3 (which stake is approximately two hundred ten feet
from Marshall Avenue) and running thence along said
Atwood Street N. 48° E. Sixty-five (65) feet to a stake on
the corner of lot no. 4; thence with line of last mentioned
lot S. 48 E. One hundred fifty-nine (159) feet to a stake
in line of land of estate of Mrs. Ann E. Marshall, deceased;
thence along the Marshall line S. 48 E. Sixty-five (65)
feet to a stake on the corner of lot no. 3; thence with
line of last mentioned lot N. 48 E. One hundred fifty-nine
(159) feet to the beginning corner, this being the same
tract of land conveyed to me by C. R. Ball by deed
dated March 5, 1924, recorded in the R. M. Co. Office for
Greenville County, S. L. in Deed Book 83, at page 102.
