 in the full and just sum of *four hundred (\$400.00) dollars*
 Dollars, to be paid *July 1st 1936*

with interest thereon, from *Dated 1936* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be
 computed and paid *annual ally*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
 principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *five per cent. of the
 amount due* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
 added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
 be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will
 more fully appear.

 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Sloan Duncan*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *H. D. Burns*, the said *H. D. Burns*,
 in hand well and truly paid by the said *Sloan Duncan*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
 and release unto the said *Sloan Duncan*, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain lot or tract of real estate located in
 Battle Township near Ebenezer Baptist Church, bounded
 on the North by lands of B. W. Sparks, on the East by W.
 A. Hester, on the South by Oscar Vidian and on the West
 by Mrs. Ellen Montgomery, containing about Thirtynine
 and one-half ($39\frac{1}{2}$) acres, more or less, and being described
 in two tracts described as follows:

Beginning at a rock, B. W. Sparks corner; thence S. $5\frac{1}{2}$
 E. 1.68 along road to a stake, thence N. $8\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.65 to a
 bend in road, thence N. $87\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.50 to a rock N. 9M.
 thence S. 80° W. 11.77 to a rock N. 9M., thence N. $85\frac{1}{2}$ W. 16.53
 to a rock N. 9M.; thence N. $42\frac{1}{4}$ E. 19.75 to a rock N. 9M.;
