SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Minnie D. Brewer, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to J. Wolfe Babb, attorney, in the full and just sum of Eighteen Thousand and ~~180~~, ¹⁸⁰ (\$18,000.00) Dollars, to be paid One year from date *Oct 19, 1919*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *7% per annum* to be computed and paid *semi-annually* until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Five (5) dollars per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *Minnie D. Brewer*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money so paid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *Minnie D. Brewer*, the said *J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney* in hand well and truly paid by the said *J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney*, his successors and assigns, forever:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Ward 2, City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, at the corner of College and Marine Streets having a frontage on College Street of Fifty-two and one-half (52 1/2) feet and a depth of One Hundred Twenty-two (122) feet on Marine Street, as shown in City Block Book at page 42. There being situated on said lot a two room house."

This being the identical lot conveyed to me, the said Minnie D. Brewer, by deed of J. P. Babb, recorded in P. M. O. Office in Volume 166, at page 544, Greenville County, South Carolina.

This being a first lien on said property, there being no other liens or encumbrances on same.
