WHEREAS, I, the said Walter Carter, in and by my certain power of attorney even date with these presents, I am well and truly indebted to J. A. Ellison in the full and just sum of Three hundred twentyone & 97/100 Dollars, to be paid to J. A. Ellison to be paid in three equal annual installments on the first day of Nov. 1935, 1936 and 1937 with interest from the date of this instrument at the rate of eleven per cent. 7% with interest thereon, from date of instrument May 1st, 1935, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note shall become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$100.00.

BY THIS DEED, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Walter Carter, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Walter Carter according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Ellison,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land containing fourteen (14) acres more or less situated and being in Grove Township, State and County aforesaid lying on west side of Grove Creek, waters of Saluda River and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning in the center (on the stream) of bridge across Grove Creek, thence S 74 1/2 W. 7.83 with road to a rock X 3 on south side of road, thence S 40 1/2 E. 1.15 to a rock X 3; thence due south 17.58 chains to bridge on the Garrison or Mill race track, thence down the meanders of said track 5.80 chains to center of Grove Creek; thence up the meanders of said creek (about) 22.35 chains to the beginning corner in the bridge bounded on the north by the lands of Jas. E. Richey on the south by lands of J. H. Charles, on the west by lands of C. V. Shilane and east by Grove Creek the same being the tract of land conveyed to R. A. Fowler by C. D. Nesbitt by deed dated May 14, 1918 and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina July 23, 1918 in Vol. 35, Page 470 and being the same tract of land conveyed to Walter Carter by R. A. Fowler deed dated Nov. 24, 1919 and not yet recorded.
