of each year until paid in full,

with interest thereon, from *January 11, 1926*, *hereby secured is paid* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually* *on the 1st of June and December*.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder
hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of *one-half percent*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, to the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,

Beginning at a stake on Sumner Street corner of
Lot no. 10, thence with line of Lot no. 10 N. 74-45-20. 150 feet
to a stake, corner of Lot no. 20, thence with line of Lot
no. 20 S. 15-15-20. 50 feet to stake in line of Lot no. 12;
thence with line of Lot no. 12 S. 74-45-20. to stake on
Sumner Street, thence with Sumner Street N. 15-15-20. 00
