 WHEREAS, I, Lillie Black, of Greenville County,
 in and by 2244 certain premises note in writing, of
 even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney,
 in the full and just sum of Two Hundred and no/100 (\$200.00) Dollars
 Dollars, to be paid One year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 6% per cent. per annum to be
 computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
 principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note is to become immediately due, at the option of the holder
 hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Eighty and no/100
(\$80.00) Dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be

added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
 any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
 reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Lillie Black, the said J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney,
 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney,
 according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney, the said

Lillie Black, in hand well and truly paid by the said J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney,
 at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do
 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Wolfe Babb, Attorney, his successors
 and assigns, forever,

"All that certain lot of land situate, lying and
 being in the Town of Simpsonville, County of Greenville
 and State of South Carolina, and on the east side of Hedge
 Street, adjoining lands of John G. Smith and Dr. W. C. Smith,
 being known and designated as Lot No. 32, as shown
 on a subdivision and Plat of S. J. Wilson Estate, made
 by S. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in August 1922, which plat is
 of record in the C. M. C. Office for Greenville County and
 State aforesaid in Plat Book 5, at page 271, and more
 particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the corner of Lot No. 31 (now J. G.
 Smith's corner) on the east side of Hedge Street, and
 running thence with line of Lot No. 31 N. 77 E. 349 feet
 to a point in the line of the Abercrombie's land (now
 Dr. Smith's Land); thence N. 15 E. 113.2 feet; thence S. 67 E. 20.
 50 feet along Dr. Smith's line to a point in line of Hedge
 Street; thence along line of said street S. 13 E. 60 feet to
 the beginning corner."

This being the same lot of land conveyed to me
 by S. G. Black on June 10, 1923, deed being recorded in C. M.
 C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 175, at page
 371.

There being situate on the above described lot a
 room bungalow. This being a first lien on the above
 described premises, there being no other liens or encumbrances
 against same.
