in the full and just sum of Six Hundred and no/100 (\$600.00) Dollars, to be paid \$100.00 on June 19, 1936; \$100.00 on June 19, 1937, and \$400.00 on June 19, 1938, with the privilege of paying an additional six multiples of \$100.00 on June 19, 1936 and June 19, 1937.

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest, at any time, be due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 15% besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the date above named to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected as an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto having more fully appear.

~~All the said tract of land or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just and within the corporate limits of Greenville, and containing the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the southwest corner of lot No. 159, as shown on plat No. 3, property of Overbrook Land Company and Greenville Investment Company, as recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book 5 at page 318, said point of beginning being the point of intersection of North line of Overbrook Road with south line of the right-of-way of the railway line of the Southern Public Utilities Company, and running thence along the north line of said Overbrook Road N. 60-33 E. 100 feet to a stake; thence continuing along said road N. 61-16 E. 112 feet to a stake; thence N. 30-14 W. 79.1 feet to a stake, the south line of said right-of-way of the Southern Public Utilities Company; thence S. 58-22 W. 35 feet to a stake; thence continuing along said right-of-way S. 51-46 W. 379 feet to the point of the beginning and being the southern portion of lot No. 169 on said plat.~~
