WHEREAS, I. J. Loftis and Lila P. Loftis in and by O. P. Earle certain note in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to O. P. Earle

in the full and just sum of One hundred and fifty-five Dollars (\$155.00) to be paid in quarterly installments of \$45.00 (plus interest) on the first day of November, 1935, and on the first day of each February, May, August and November thereafter, to and including May 1, 1937, all balance remaining unpaid to be due and payable on August 1, 1937, with interest thereon, from

computed and paid quarterly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount of said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10) per cent.

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00), the said.

I. J. Loftis and Lila P. Loftis do hereby convey and assign to O. P. Earle in hand well and truly paid by the said O. P. Earle on the 1st day of October, 1935 at 5:44 P.M.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said O. P. Earle, the tract of land described as follows:

parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, in Ward One of the City of Greenville on the east side of Robinson Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Begins at a stake on the east side of Robinson Street a distance of 100 feet from the southeast corner of Robinson and Craft Streets, and running thence south Robinson Street, S. 1-41 W. 45 feet to a tree pin, thence S. 89-13 E. 108 feet 9 inches to a stake on the western line of Lot no. 29. Thence south the western line of Lot no. 24, N. 1-41 E. 45 feet to a stake, thence N. 89-13 E. 108 feet 9 inches to the beginning corner, and being the central portion of Lot no. 27, of Section 6, of Stone Land Company, according to plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, pages 337-340, and being the same conveyed to us by Daniel R. Bain, Trustee by deed dated June 7, 1933 and recorded in Volume 171, Page 60.
