Personally appeared James R. Hudgens and made oath as follows:

That he is administrator of the Estate of W. K. Hudgens, deceased, and as such is the custodian of the books and records of said decedent. That after thorough inquiry and investigation he is satisfied that the mortgage executed by J. A. Donald to the said W. K. Hudgens on November 9, 1920, duly recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, S. C., on November 24, 1920, in Book 93, at page 2, has been paid. That a certified copy of said mortgage, as appears on the record as aforesaid, was pledged as collateral by deponent's intestate to Federal Intermediate Credit Bank during the year 1927. The indebtedness for which said mortgage was pledged was paid in full and the instrument evidencing the same is now in deponent's possession, and said mortgage was surrendered by the said Federal Intermediate Credit Bank on November 8, 1927. According to the books and records of said intestate he was the owner and holder of said mortgage at the time of his death, which occurred on the 7th day of July, 1928, and said instrument was not then hypothecated, assigned or otherwise transferred. Said instrument cannot now be found, although diligent search has been made. Deponent further states that said note and mortgage was fully paid, as appears from the most accurate information obtainable by deponent from the books and records and sworn statements of said mortgagor, unto the said W. K. Hudgens by the execution and delivery unto the said W. K. Hudgens of the note and mortgage bearing date April 1, 1921, recorded in the office of Register Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, S. C., in Vol. 95, at Page 218, it being the purpose and intention of the parties thereto, as deponent is informed, to merge the indebtedness secured by said lost mortgage in the indebtedness secured by said mortgage so recorded in book 95, at page 218.
