WHEREAS, I, the said J. W. Bates

in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Mrs. Clessie Rogers Turner, as Guardian for Jeannie Turner in the full and just sum of Four Hundred

Dollars, to be paid One year after date

with interest thereon from computed and at the rate of 6% per cent. per annum, to be paid in full, all interest not then due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the same in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor agrees to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness, or attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Mrs. Clessie Rogers Turner, in hand well and truly paid by the said J. W. Bates, at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mrs. Clessie Rogers Turner, as Guardian for Jeannie Turner, the following described property, to wit: All that land, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Tract No. 1 of the Estate of J. F. Bates and containing 51 acres, more or less, according to a plat and survey by W. A. Hester dated Feb. 6, 1932, land having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the Keeler Mill Road corner of land of Mrs. Shulader and running thence with the Keeler Mill Road in the south westerly direction 25.30 to an iron ring, corner of tract no 2 of Estate of J. F. Bates, and running thence N. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 44.00 to a stone o. m.; thence N. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 51.30 to a stone o. m.; thence N. 44 W. 7.63 to a stone o. m.; thence S. 72 W. 17.67 to a N. O.; thence N. 46 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 4.50 to a stake on the Keeler Mill Road, the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to me by Deeds dated August 15, 1935 and recorded in the R. M. B.
