 the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, the owner and
 holder of the mortgage hereinafter referred to and of the note there-
 by secured, does hereby, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated,
 release and forever discharge from the lien of that certain mort-
 gage from Clough C. Good to The First Carolinas Joint Stock Land
 Bank, securing the payment of the principal sum of Sixty-Two
 Hundred (\$6200.00) Dollars, dated the 12th day of November, 1926,
 and recorded in the office of the C.C.C. P. & S. and for R.M.C.
 for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Mortgage Book
 181, at Page 210, the following described property, to-wit:
 all that certain tract or parcel of land containing six and
 89/100 (6.89) acres, more or less, in Gantt Township, Greenville
 County, South Carolina, being tract No. 14 on plat made by G. A. Ellis
 Surveyor, dated July 8, 1936, and more fully described therein as
 follows:

Begin on the South line of the original tract on the West side of the
 Piedmont-Greenville Highway and run North 694 feet along said
 highway; thence South 71 degrees 30 minutes West 750 feet to a
 stake; thence South 48 degrees East 33.5 feet to a stone, thence South
 87 degrees 30 minutes East 233.5 feet to said highway, the point
 of beginning.

Provided, However, that the security of The Federal Land Bank of
 Columbia as described in the aforesaid mortgage shall, in all re-
 spects, except as to the premises hereinbefore described, be pre-
 served and protected and that the lien of said mortgage, ex-
 cept as hereby released and discharged, shall remain in
 full force and effect and the terms, conditions and cove-
 nants of said mortgage, and of the note thereby secured, shall
 remain unchanged.
