*we* the said mortgagors Have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
unto the said mortgagee:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate,  
lying and being in Chick Springs Township, State and  
County aforesaid, on the south-east side of the Brushy  
Creek Road, about one-half mile from Well and having  
the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning  
on iron pin in the center of the said Brushy Creek Road,  
N. N. White corner and running thence along said road  
S. 42 N. 5.82 chs. to a less thence continuing with said  
road N. 82 N. 6.68 chs. and 156 links to another bend in said  
road, thence still continuing with said road N. 73 N.  
3.03 chs. to an iron pin on north side of said road, N.  
L. Henderson's and N. F. Green's corner, thence with said  
N. L. Henderson's line N. 26 E. 21.30 chs. to an iron pin in
