NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release

unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situated in the county of Greenville

State of South Carolina:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about four miles south of the City of Greenville near Santt Station, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1, 6 and 15, on plat of property of W. S. Garrison, Santt, S. C. made by Brodie D. Bedell July 9, 1913, and recorded in the R. M. L. office for Greenville County in Plat Book 6 at page 98.

Lots 1 and 6 having in the aggregate the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of the National Highway, and running thence along the east side of said highway in a northerly direction 251 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 1 and 7; thence along the joint line of lots 6, 7, 1 and 2, N. 80-50 E. 627 feet to an iron pin in Piedmont Road; thence along said Piedmont Road in a southerly direction 151 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 15, thence S. 66-0 21. 483 feet to an iron pin in the east side of the National Highway, the point of beginning.

Lot no. 15 is described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Piedmont Road and running thence along said Road in a northerly direction 605 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 61-45 E. 409 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 66-0 21. 765 feet to the point of beginning.
