AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$ 1250.00) Dollars, payable to the order of the second party,
together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum,
the first payment of interest being due and payable on the lst of October, and thereafter interest being
due and payable annually; said principal sum being due and payable in Ten (10) equal, successive, annual
installments ofOne Hundred Twenty-Five and Nov100(\$_125.00) Dollars each, and a final install-
ment of

said principal being due and payable on the 1st October, 1939_, and thereafter the remaining installments of
principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.
NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:
All that certain tract of land containing Forty-five and 15/100 (45.15) acres, more
or less, known as W. A. Mullinax farm, on the Buncombe Road (Old Pelham Road), Two (2) miles
South of Greer, in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and
