I, Clara Mae Alexander, of Greenville SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, the said Clara Mae Alexander

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to  
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100

(\$ 500.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of NINE AND NO/100  
(\$ 9.00) Dollars upon the first
