WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto The Prudential Insurance Company of America.

Thirty-two Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$ 3,200.00), with interest from date at the rate of four and one-half percentum (4½ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of The Prudential Insurance Company of America in Newark, N.J., or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Seventeen and 79/100 Dollars (\$ 17.79), commencing on the first day of February, 1943, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of January, 1968.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of King Avenue, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 23 on plat of Parkview made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June, 1942, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, at page 49, and having, according to said plat, and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, December 17, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of King Avenue at joint front corner of Lots No. 23 and 24, said pin also being 25 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the point where the Northeast side of King Avenue intersects with the Southeast side of Haviland Avenue, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 24, N. 63° 45' E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lots No. 43 and 44, N. 26° 15' W. 78.3 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Haviland Avenue; thence with the Southeast side of Haviland Avenue, S. 53° 02' W. 127.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of Haviland Avenue to an iron pin on the Northeast side of King Avenue (the chord of which is S. 13° 23' W. 38.7 feet); thence along the Northeast side of King Avenue, S. 26° 15' E. 25 feet to the beginning corner.
