AND in case of default in the payment of said debt or interest thereon, and likewise in case of default in any of the agreements hereinabove set forth, the Mortgagor hereby assigns the rents and profits of the above described premises to the Mortgagee, and agrees that any Judge of the Circuit Court of said State may at Chambers, or otherwise, appoint a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect the rents and profits, and after payment costs of collection, apply the proceeds to the payment of said debt, interest, costs and expenses, without liability, however, to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.

AND it is further agreed and covenanted between the said parties that in case the debt secured by this Mortgage or any part thereof is collected by suit or action or this Mortgage be formalosed, or put into the hands of an attorney for collection, suit, action or foreclosure, the said Mortgagor, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall be chargeable with all costs of collection, including ten (10%) per cent. of the principal and interest on the amount involved as attorney's fee, which shall be due and payable at once, which charges and fees, together with all costs and expenses, are hereby secured and may be recovered in any suit or action hereupon or hereunder.
