(\$ 4,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of FORTY AND NO/100 (\$ 40.00) Dollars upon the first

E., in June, 1938, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Bennett street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 9 and T-10, which point is 76 feet north of the northeast corner of the intersection of Bennett street with Croft street, and running thence along the line of Lots 9 and T-10, S. 70-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19-30 E. 51 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. T-10 and T-11; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 70-30 W. 150 feet to the joint corner of said lots on the east side of Bennett street, at a point 101 feet south of Russell avenue; thence along the east side of Bennett street, S. 19.30 W. 51 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Mrs. Walter M. Lee by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded.
